Every series on Brilliant TV contains Brilliant Perspectives designed to have a powerful impact on how we see, think, speak and act.

The Holy Spirit provides the impulse of how the real truth about our new man in Christ can resonate through every life situation.

The impact of God's empowering presence will always have a massive influence on our real identity in the Kingdom.

Part of your renewal in thinking and trusting is to ponder those words at the start of each day.

In Jesus, you are yoked to the unchanging beauty of how God sees you in His Son.

Never, ever start a new day with a negative thought or emotion.

Instead, pick a Truth and start your day with it!

I adore Lamentations 3:21-24 because it begins and ends in hope which translates as expectation.

"This I recall to mind therefore I have Hope.

The Lord's loving kindness indeed never ceases. For His compassions never fail.

They are new every morning, great is
Your faithfulness.

The Lord is my portion, says my soul,
therefore I have hope in Him.”

It is important to establish a context for
how you approach the God of life, love,
and laughter.

Scriptural context is the parts of a
passage or a particular verse which
precede and also follow a particular line
of thought.

That thought is designed to create a
specific focus.

It is focus that upgrades trust and
rejoicing.

Scripture puts you in the same creative
space as the Father so that He can work
on you with joy.

Context empowers our heart to become
joyfully fixed on God's nature in Himself.

David, in the midst of some extreme
persecution from Saul, wrote this Psalm
57 in the wilderness.

The beating heart of this psalm is the
effect that God's nature had on David
that made him shout for joy:

“My heart is fixed O God, my heart is
fixed! I will sing, yes! I will sing praises.” 57
v. 7

Our mind also can become set on
God...which will release a flow of thinking
built on thanksgiving.

Truth and its meaning must impact on our heart so it can refresh our joy and peace in believing in God's love.

Truth lived in the heart can renew our mind, providing us with the only way to think about who God is for me and therefore who I am in Him.

The word "therefore" means: for that reason!

As a result of this scripture, this promise, this prophecy...something powerful will occur in you, for you, around you, as you joyfully trust in God's word.

In Lamentations 3, the word "therefore" book ends the verses 21 and 24.

21: "This I recall to mind, therefore I have Hope."

KEY THOUGHT = Heart always has precedence over the mind. The heart [inner man] is where God dwells within us...

...so that we become One with how He sees and feels about us.

This upgrades our thinking process in Christ.

Whenever you access the mind of Christ or operate from a renewed mind, it is because you have had your heart impacted by His nature and it has created an expectation in your mind.

We are always defined by the intentions of God. When I recall what God has done for me, expectation rises up within.

When I meditate on God's true nature (not what religion expresses about Him) then, trust with expectation produces the joy and peace in believing, which becomes faith.

Lamentations 3:24: "The Lord is my portion, says my soul...

Therefore I have hope in Him."

When the weakest part of you knows for sure that you belong to God, anything is possible.

When your fluctuating uncertainty knows the truth that God never lies, then His righteousness creates faith in us!

He cannot lie! My heart exults in His nature.

He is the Truth! Therefore I can stand up and look my situation in the face...and smile.

God's nature must become our inner kingdom. Our secret place in Him, with Him.

If I belong to Him then He belongs to me. He is my portion, which means inheritance.

So vital that you see yourself in Him and you know the double portion of Christ in you!

The Truth that sets me free from condemnation, shame, guilt and blame is this:

Lamentations 3:22 "The Lord's loving kindnesses indeed never cease!

For His compassions never fail.”

That is a double hit on negativity!

All that God is in Himself will not cease or fail us because of His presence in us and with us!

Jeremiah is thinking about God's mercy and the expectation it releases in his own life...

...so his heart exuberance allows him to draw on God's nature in the prophetic word.

God cannot lie! His loving kindness will not cease! His compassion will not fail!

They are relentlessly NEW every morning...because God's faithfulness really is SO GREAT!!

As God's child, be exuberant! Overflow with praise. Abound in joy. You have good reason!

Joy will counteract any negativity in your life. “Rejoice in The Lord always...and again I say, REJOICE!!”

It's not an option. It is a necessity.

Start every day fresh. Never carry over a negative thought from yesterday into today.

Make your present day powerful. Start it in joy. End it in joy.

And the inbetween is where God will create the same vibrant expectation that exists in the Three.

This is the place where Three + Me becomes real.

In our heart, mind, voice, and actions, we join with fullness of who God always is in Himself, and in you!

“God works in you, to will and to do for His good pleasure.” Philippians 2:13

“For we are His workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand so that we would walk in them.” Ephesians 2:10

Let's read it also in The Passion Translation:

Philippians 2:13...

“God will continually revitalize you, implanting within you the passion to do what pleases Him.”

Ephesians 2:10 “We have become His poetry, a re-created people that will fulfill the destiny He has given each of us...

...for we are joined to Jesus, The Anointed One.

Even before we were born, God planned in advance our destiny and the good words we would do to fulfill it.”

That is astonishing to me!

It is a huge declaration of intent from God's heart to us.

Read and study these two scriptures and think about the Creator at work in you!

Now I know, many of you have lived in a religious world that has not upgraded

you from a servant to being the Beloved of God.

Some of you struggle with unworthiness, with old thoughts, habits and guilt.

None of those are necessary because Jesus paid a price for that freedom.

You have been free in God's heart from your first day of salvation. You are free now, at this moment, in Jesus.

In Brilliant TV, we treat you as free. Just as the Creator does in Jesus.

You are unlearning from legalism and joyfully learning about who you really are in Jesus.

Religion and legalism are like being in prison.

You feel confined, limited, helpless, and hopeless.

Your state weighs in on your heart and mind. Everyday is dull, dreary and monotonous.

You exist, without the joy of being fully alive. You can see the sun, feel it...

... but you are confined by the walls built around you.

The longer you live in that environment, the more you are conditioned by it.

I have seen people released from a long sentence who find it so hard to adjust to the real world.

They are institutionalized by their prolonged experience of confinement.

People coming out of legalism often feel guilty about being loved fully by the Father.

Religion traps people into a life of performance so they can earn God's approval, acceptance and be rewarded for good behavior.

Three + Me means that we become the architects of our growth, freedom, and presence with God.

The world engages in behaviour that earns a reward.

The Kingdom does the opposite. It gives you an identity with the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit right from the beginning.

God gives everything as a gift that can never be earned.

Each gift is an important part of your identity in the Three!

Father, Son and Holy Spirit are all One and, in Christ, we are put into that same unity and Oneness with Them.

Father loves us in the same way He loves Jesus; fully and unconditionally.

This is the prayer of Jesus that still has the same truth and power today that was evident when He first prayed it in John 17:21-23.

In the Passion Translation:

"I pray for them all to be joined together as one...

Even as You and I, Father, are joined together as One.

I pray for them to become One with us!

So that the world will recognize that You sent me.

For the very glory You have given to Me, I have given them.

So that they will be joined together as one, and experience the same unity that We enjoy!

You live fully in Me and now I live full in them,

so that they will experience Our perfect unity and the world will be convinced that You have sent Me,

for they will see that You love each one of them with the same passionate love that You have for Me."

Jesus, who according to Hebrews 7:25 ever lives to make intercession for us, is no doubt praying that same prayer for you!

So here is a crafted prayer that you can pray and join with Jesus!

Father, it is absolutely true that I am in You in the same way as Jesus.

There is no doubt that I am an essential part of The Oneness and unity of the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.

I am Your beloved because You love me the same as You love Your Beloved Son.

There is no shame or condemnation for any mistake I make as I am learning to grow up in all things in Christ.

The Three are fully alive in me and I thank You that I will constantly encounter Their presence until I am fully living in Their life as my normal experience.

Thank you that every day begins with newness of life.

I am so happy that You never carry over a deficit from one day to another.

All things are new for me and as I am growing up in Your love...my heart and my mind will become One with Your presence.

I relax and rest in Your delight, in Jesus, in me.

Fill me with Your Holy Spirit now, at this time, so that I may revel in Your beautiful presence.

In Jesus name... Amen.

Context is also a framework for processing what is most real about Christ in me!

1 John 4:17 "As He is, so am I, in this world."

The Truth creates an ambience (inner atmosphere) that becomes the joy and peace in believing.

That inner connection with Christ in you gives you a frame of reference....

...a context! For all the relationship and fellowship that God will have with you...

...regardless of circumstances...

THIS IS YOUR TRUTH!

I also love the absolute truth of God's nature in that He is Unchanging and forever the same!

I live in the space between two great truths about God's nature... Malachi 3:6 and Hebrews 13:8.

Hebrews 13:8 "Jesus Christ is the same, yesterday and today and forever!"

Your past, present, and future are already part of your identity in Christ.

We have a massive assurance that our entire life experience is part of our Oneness and truth in the Lord Jesus Christ.

We are cleansed by His blood, renewed and refreshed by the Spirit, and accepted in the Beloved by Father, Son, and Spirit.

Our old nature is dead and we are learning to be alive to God in Christ Jesus. Romans 6:11

All the mistakes we make in our learning are covered by the newness of Life in Christ.

When all things are made new, 2 Corinthians 5:17, we get to start everyday,

every situation, every difficulty, from a place of newness in Jesus.

Jesus is the same every day in every way. Each day holds an engagement for us in God's utmost presence.

I also love Malachi 3:6 "For I the Lord, do not change, therefore you, O sons of Jacob, are not consumed."

I love that God is Unchanging here but what fascinates me is His reference to Jacob.

In Genesis 25:26, Jacob is the second born brother of a twin.

He came out of the womb holding onto his brother's heel.

His name reflects that action.

He is variously known as the heel catcher, the supplanter, one who will overthrow another for his own purpose.

God spoke to his mother while she was pregnant...Genesis 25:23,

saying that both would struggle together and one would triumph but that the elder would serve the younger.

Growing up, Esau would be favored by his father and Jacob by his mother.

Years later, Esau foolishly sold his birthright to his brother for some bread and lentil stew.

Fast forward years later (Genesis 27) Jacob and his mother conspire against

Esau and his father to steal the blessing of the firstborn (verses 18-24).

Jacob lied three times to his father; in the second lie he misrepresented God,

He served the food and received Esau's blessing.

Verses 30-41 recount the awful story of the negative impact on Esau.

Jacob has an encounter with God (Ch. 32) where God changes his name from Jacob to Israel.

From deceiver and supplanter to one who will have the power to be a prince and who will know the strength of God (Ch 32 verse 28).

Now here we are in the latter stages of the Old Testament writing and God speaks to Malachi these words...

"For I, the Lord, do not change, therefore you, O sons of Jacob, are not consumed."

Fascinating that He would use Jacob's name.

A liar, deceiver, and one who would cheat his brother and steal his blessing.

In this context, God is demonstrating His unchanging nature towards those who are sinful, untruthful, deceptive, and who steal even from family.

This is on a par with Luke 6:35, "for God Himself is kind to evil and ungrateful men."

What we learn here is what judgmental people hate.

That is, the nature of God will touch everyone righteous and the unrighteous.

His unchanging nature works hand in hand with His unchanging purpose, expressed in Gen 1:26.

“Let us make man in Our image, and according to Our likeness.”

When God enters our life, His presence and favor changes us dramatically.

Jacob becomes Israel, a Prince in the Old Covenant.

In the New Covenant we are baptised into Christ. A sinner receives divine favor in Jesus.

One who is distressed and anxious becomes one with the Prince of Peace.

There is no point in us being down on ourselves when we are elevated into God’s nature.

We become accepted in the Beloved.

Ephesians 1 verses 2-8 is an astonishing blessing that comes to us from God’s Unchanging nature. In the Passion translation...

“May God Himself, the heavenly Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, release grace over you and impart total well being into your lives.

Every spiritual blessing in the heavenly realm has already been lavished upon us

as a love gift from our wonderful
Heavenly Father...

...the Father of our Lord Jesus...

...all because He sees us wrapped into
Jesus.

This is why we celebrate Him with all our
hearts.

And He chose us to be His very own.

Joining us to Himself even before He laid
the foundation of the universe!

Because of His great love, He ordained
us, so that we would be seen as holy in
His eyes with an unstained innocence.

For it was always in His perfect plan to
adopt us as His delightful children,
through our union with Jesus the
Anointed One...

...so that His tremendous love that
cascades over us would glorify His grace...

... for the same love He has for His
Beloved One, Jesus, He has for us!

And this unfolding plan brings Him great
pleasure!

Since we are now joined to Christ, we
have been given the treasures of
redemption by His blood.

This is the total cancellation of our sins.

All because of the cascading riches of His
grace.

This super abundant grace is already
powerfully working in us,

as it releases within us all forms of wisdom and practical understanding.”

I love sitting inside God’s heart and reading scripture aloud.

The spoken word always goes deeper into the inner man when it is heard rather than just thought.

When speaking aloud, our voice can match the tone of His heart and it therefore creates a oneness that makes us more open and vulnerable to His goodness and kindness.

Reading Ephesians 1:2-8 aloud over a number of years and talking to the Holy Spirit has created a very powerful link with the Spirit of Truth.

This has created an imprint of this passage in my heart that has made my heart become fixed!

The heart imprint has wonderfully adjusted my mind in agreement and focus creating a mind set on the Spirit.

The Spirit of Truth and I have become one with this word.

The result of that is, I am no longer vulnerable to any other influence.

I know what God wants to be for me in this regard, and I am not, simply not, going to give that oneness away to anything else.

Becoming sure and certain of God’s truth in me, for me, is too precious to discard.

It is my life now and my future going forward.

Once we have learned and established a truth in God's reality...

...we can stand on that truth and it becomes the Rock on which any storm breaks itself.

Learn this properly and it will never leave. It will rule over the old you by constantly releasing the new, without you having to think about it.

Your heart is fixed and your mind is set.

By establishing a truth as your reality with the Three, you ensure that you live above that problem, never under it.

Building our inner house upon The Rock elevates us from above.

Failure to do so means that every negative event confirms to us that we live on sinking sand. Matthew 7:24-28.

Scripture promises: These are Lamentations 3:21-24, Hebrews 13:8, Malachi 3:6, Philippians 2:13 and Ephesians 2:10.

Words to study, think about and assimilate in your heart so that your mind is also renewed.

Ephesians 1:18 is for your devotional pleasure. It will expand your heart and mind together!

I want to end this episode with a prophetic word that encapsulates all that the Father wants you to hear and see,

regarding His heart for you, and therefore who you get to become in Him.

[Prophetic word]

“Beloved, I am training you to live from where I live in you!

You must settle the question of ownership in your life.

It is vital to confess that you belong to the Creator, the Redeemer, and the Helper/Comforter.

Together, We are your Spirit of Truth.

We are the wisdom and revelation that guides you and empowers your life in every situation.

We are the Rock on which you stand. We are the Fortress, the High Tower that you can run into, be safe and also learn to become powerful.

Your eye must become single, with a focus on Us that creates expectation for your circumstances.

You need to see, agree, and trust that we are Unchanging in your life.

Therefore, you immediately banish fear, stress, anxiety and the struggle that so easily wraps itself around your heart and mind.

All the old has passed away. Everything has become new.

When you consider yourself to be dead to sin, your capacity to engage with Me fully will make your life astonishing.

I love the Son in you therefore I love you.

You are included, involved, and engaged with Us in all things pertaining to life and godliness.

Jesus in you, loves Me. That is why everything in you is a gift given to Jesus in you.

This is your expectation. That you can receive, in Jesus, everything that is now yours as the Beloved.

The Beloved Son in you empowers you to become the Beloved.

I delight in loving Jesus in you, therefore I delight in you as you practice newness of life.

You will make mistakes as you are learning but they are already covered in the blood of sacrifice.

You are one with the Three. Anything less than that is a lie.

All the time spent building a life on the sand means you are living in deception and hopelessness.

Legalism creates a focus on behavior that makes you responsible for the power that you need, to change your old life.

This is futile and self defeating.

My Beloved Son did all the work necessary for your freedom by dying in your place.

He did not just die for you. He died as you to ensure once and for all that you are fully and totally redeemed.

There is nothing you can do to change the old man into someone better.

The old is dead and can never be renewed. It is gone and can never be your focus for life.

You must stop exhuming this corpse and carrying it around with you.

We only focus on the New, True, Real you in Jesus. All your change begins with the acceptance that you are now a new creation.

Christ in you, guarantees that you will be loved always and in everything.

Love conquers all things, even the messy areas of life.

My passion for Jesus includes you! This is why I placed Him in you and put you into Him.

I rejoice that you are in Our safe place as you practice being and becoming the beloved.

Start your day as the Beloved. Live as the Beloved all day, today!

End your day as the Beloved.

EVERYDAY, OUR DELIGHT IN JESUS IN YOU...IS OUR GIFT TO YOU. IN OUR HEARTS THEREFORE, YOU ARE THE BELOVED.

This truth is meant to astonish you!

Amen, thank You, Lord!! Listen to the word constantly.

This is who you are becoming. Life is so much easier when you live from your identity.

Know what God wants to be for you now!

As you listen to the message, the Truth will begin to connect with you.

There will be things for you to unlearn.

Truth always confounds the lie that legalism has forced upon us.

The important part of this process is that you are convinced by both the Word and The Spirit of Truth.

That Truth is setting you free even as you listen, perceive, and think at a higher level.

As your heart enlarges, your mind is renewed.

Confidence in God's nature will rise up in the form of joy...as in John 15:11. Jesus said:

"These words I have spoken to you so that(!) My joy may be in you, and that (!) your joy may be made full."

With each key of truth you receive, take a few moments to praise the Lord and rejoice in Him.

Rejoicing anchors the truth in your heart.

In this episode, as you experience God's pleasure and delight in you, it is normal

for His intentions to have an impact on your heart and mind.

The kind intentions of God are a vital part of our relational practice in Jesus.

There are some assignment ideas that will empower your thinking. These are included in the notes.

The main part of your learning however, is in the transcript of:

- The Scripture Promises
- The Crafter Prayer
- The Prophetic Word
- The understanding of what God wants to be for you NOW!
